At the Rokin in Amsterdam, Ivy Group has developed two luxury warehouses in collaboration with architectural office Rijnboutt and main contractor Van Wijnen. One of these buildings features a unique rounded roof structure cladded with panels. The structure is 80 meters long and consists of a gridshell with 423 rhombus shaped sandwich panels. The structure houses a restaurant.

The roof structure is 80 meters long and consists of a gridshell cladded with 423 rhombus shaped sandwich panels. Because of the semi-circular shape of the roof structure, it is capable of supporting its own weight, thus eliminating the need for supporting columns. This creates a spacious floor plan inside without obstructions of the widespread view over the city of Amsterdam.
