Triodos Bank's new office was designed by RAU Architects and built by J.P. van Eesteren. It is the first large-scale 100% wooden, remountable office building. Three transparent towers run from south to north and are alternately connected on the ground, first and second floors. The composition and shape of the five-storey building is inspired by nature and respects the rhythm of the surrounding flora and fauna.

An optimal integration was sought between the building and its surroundings. The organic building has a unique wood construction in the ceiling that refers to the traces of a mushroom and is surrounded by a sloping glass facade developed by Octatube. The facade provides maximum transparency and offers an all-round view of the surrounding landscape. For Triodos Bank co-workers, it feels as if they are working outside, from the comfort of a perfect indoor climate.



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
